

Report from Train the trainer seminar in Neum: 25.2.2007.-2.3.2007.

Seminar is organized in order to train the trainers on Medical faculties in BH for new teaching and learning methods in Medical education.

All trainers from BH Medical faculties were selected carefully according to the previous experience in INTEL-M TEMPUS project and other activities on their own faculties related with introducing of new teaching and learning methods.

Future trainers had opportunity to see practical demonstration of different methodologies like Sandwich principle, Four step Payton, OSCE methodology, clinical skills and microteaching. The whole seminar was organized like combination of plenary sessions and work in small groups. Seminar was led by tutors from BH, who were trained in Heidelberg. They were supported by German experts, who were consultants during this seminar.

On the beginning of each session short introduction of methodology was presented to the participants. After that participants were divided in the small groups and work practically. In the end all groups came together for discussion and final evaluation of the seminar.

During seminar participants were also introduced with organizational aspects of such seminar starting from definition of seminar objectives, group work, till the reflections and satisfaction of all participants.

It was discussed about next dissemination seminars in BH and specially about role of tutors, technical issues, selection of methodologies which should be included in seminar.

Seminar was organized on high level and tutors generally played role which was planned for them.

Groups had nice time together and all of participants expressed their hope that they will continue working together with other teams on introducing teaching methodologies on Medical faculties in BH.
